One of the questions we are often asked is "How can I get to the second floor?"


The library's staircase is hidden at the far end of the reading room.

There are also 26 power seats where you can bring your laptop.




#### 2F English Learning Books

YSL is a library with a long history, inheriting its collection from the Third High School, the predecessor of Kyoto University.


































Wa-on (環On)
